Dear user,

thank you for choosing the ICEbear USB JTAG emulator.

Before you plug in your ICEbear, it is recommended to follow the installation instructions in the manual – see list of documentation resources below.

If you obtained a bulk version of the ICEbear (without CD shipped), please find the CD image at: http://www.section5.ch/dsp/icebear/icebear-1_0.iso

Documentation resources

- ICEbear manual: See `doc/ICEbear-manual.pdf` on the CD. Under Windows, click the 'Read manual' button after the CD is inserted and automatically opened. Under Linux, see also `index.html` on the CD.
- After installation on Windows, the library and API documentation is found under the 'Documentation' entry of the ICEbear program group found in the Windows Start Menu.
- Under Linux, the same documentation is found in the `doc/` subfolder of the ICEbear installation tar file (see `linux/` folder on the CD).
